- Vaginal area
- External genitals
- Cervix

Men also can develop sores in or on the:

- Penis
- Scrotum

Genital herpes is different for each person. The signs and symptoms may recur, off and on, for years. Some people experience numerous episodes each year.

During a recurrence, shortly before sores appear, you'll feel:

- Burning, tingling and itching where the infection first entered in our body
- Pain in your lower back, buttocks and legs

However, recurrences are generally less painful than the first outbreak, and sores generally heal more quickly.

Causes

Two sorts of herpes simplex virus infections can cause genital herpes:

Risk factors

Your risk of becoming infected with herpes genitalis may increase if you:

- Are a woman. Women are more likely to possess herpes genitalis than are men. The virus is sexually transmitted more easily from men to women than it's from women to men.
- Have multiple sexual partners. Each additional sexual partner raises your risk of being exposed to the virus that causes herpes genitalis.

Prevention

The suggestions for preventing genital herpes are the same as those for preventing other sexually transmitted infections: limit sexual contact to only one person who is infection-free. Short of that, you can:

You should practice safe sex and use condoms every time you have sex with someone. This will help prevent herpes genitalis and other STDs from spreading.

There's no cure for genital herpes, but the condition can be managed with medication. Avoid intercourse if either partner has an epidemic of herpes within the genital area or anywhere else
